

FIELD RULES

1. All members and guests are required to have a State Park permit (MVP).
2. No alcoholic beverages allowed at the flying field. Pilots who show obvious influence shall not fly.
3. Flying is not permitted over neighboring homes or behind the flight line. The flight line shall be established along the south side of the flying field.
4. No more than four (4) planes in the air at one time.
5. All aerobatics are to be flown north of the runway.
6. Frequency flags are required on all transmitters at all times.
7. Frequency clips must be placed on the transmitter before turning the transmitter on.
8. Frequency clips shall be used in a rotational order if there is more than one pilot on a given frequency.
9. All pilots must have a current Academy of Model Aeronautics (AMA) membership card.
10. Aircraft or radio equipment which are obviously unsafe will not be allowed to fly. Static display only.
11. All AMA and club safety rules apply.
12. Landing aircraft have the right-of-way over all other aircraft. However, during periods of great activity, pilots will use some discretion when he/she has a choice.
13. Each pilot is responsible for the removal of all debris his/her presence may have caused.
14. All engines over .051 cu. in. displacement must have mufflers.
15. The maximum noise level will be 90 DB at 9 feet. An A-weighted DB meter will regulate engines with a certificate of compliance issued to each flier prior to flight. No internal combustion engines will be flown without mufflers.
16. All transmitters must be narrow-band. A gold sticker from an AMA approved transmitter sticker station is required. Transmitters should be checked by an AMA approved sticker station on a regular basis.
17. Any improvements on the site must have a written Parks and Recreation Division approval and costs for such improvements will be the responsibility of the club.
18. Flying times: 10:00 a.m. to dusk.
 - a. EXCEPTION: No flying of planes on November 15
19. The site must be kept site mowed, clean, and orderly. The specific areas to be mowed will be specified by the Park Manager. We are responsible for maintaining the area including all required mowing, replacement of barrier post, as needed, repairs to entrance gate, impound stand, painting and staining as needed, and maintenance of refuse receptacles.
20. All State Park Rules and Regulations apply.
21. All members are expected to abide by the Field Rules and Constitution/By-laws or subject the club to forfeit of the lease we hold with the DNR.
